

# Tall Pines Board Meeting June 13, 2019 7:00 pm

#### **MINUTES**

The meeting was called to order by the President, Dawn Horvath, at 7:00 pm. Board members present were Dawn Horvath, Bud Johnson, Bob Krobatsch, Kevin Van Nort, A. J. Douglas and Jack Brandt.

Absent were David Antkowiak, Carl Cassella and Paula Morin. A quorum was established. Dora Steed and Jennifer Rivera from Parklane Real Estate Services was also present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was observed.

Notice of the meeting was posted in the Hi Lites and on the property.

Bud made a motion to approve and waive reading of the May 8, 2019 meeting minutes with one correction. Under <u>Old Business</u>; <u>Update on the signs to be installed throughout the community</u>: The sentence beginning with Three signs should be changed to Four signs. Jack seconded the motion; motion carried.

<u>Treasurer`s Report</u>: A. J. presented the Treasurer's Report as of May 31, 2019. Year-to-date income was \$50,800 and expenses were \$45,753. The operating account balance was \$30,674. The total reserves were \$296,783.

<u>Clubhouse Manager`s Report</u>: A. J. reported that there is a potential rental (wedding) for July 20<sup>th</sup> and a second rental in August (birthday party).

<u>Crime Watch Report:</u> There was a traffic and safety meeting on May 22<sup>nd</sup>. Approximately a dozen homeowners were in attendance. Items discussed were residents and nonresidents speeding and cutting through. The Committee had four recommendations: fining, blocking the golf path, restarting the neighborhood watch program and gating the community. The next meeting is scheduled for June 20<sup>th</sup> at 7 PM.

#### **Old Business:**

<u>Front Entrance Sign:</u> All of the signs have been painted except for the clubhouse sign. It is being scheduled at this time.

Update on the signs to be installed throughout the community: Jennifer Rivera spoke with Derek Berger from the County regarding the Hunt Ridge streets being deeded back to Tall Pines. He stated that the streets should be deeded back with no problems by late July or early August. We will be contacted when the cycle has been completed.

Jack made a motion to complete the purchase and installation of the four previously approved signs (three stops and one 20 MPH) sign for \$2,560. This total price includes 4 mow pad bases at \$40.00 each. A \$1,200 deposit was made in November to build the signs; balance due \$1,360. Kevin seconded the motion; motion carried.

All the signs throughout the community (approximately 39) are leaning and need the installation of mow pads. Kevin will arrange with the sign company to inspect the signs. The sign company should then present a bid to the management company for Board review.

Landscaping project update: The front island has been completed. Dawn is to verify if the stumps were to be ground down as part of the original proposal. The dead tree on Upton Ct is scheduled to be removed June 14<sup>th</sup>. The Hunt Ridge entrance is scheduled next; once the County trims their part. The subsequent project will be the cleanup of Upton Court facing Decubellis.

<u>LaQuinta erosion</u>: The drain and the culvert on LaQunita Dr was scoped. No corrosion was noted. The erosion is scheduled to be repaired once the water table goes down.

<u>Pothole:</u> There is a pothole on Buitas Des Morts. A bid for \$152 was presented and approved by the Board; however, Bud and Bob will see if they can fix it first.

<u>Library Chairs:</u> Bob presented an example of another new library chair. Everyone liked the chair. They are \$89 each (the Board has one \$10 coupon). An extended warranty can be

purchased for \$17 per chair which would provide a seven-year warranty/three-year unconditional. The total price per chair with tax and delivery would be approximately \$101 per chair (total of 10 chairs). Kevin made a motion to approve \$1,100 and proceed to have Dawn order the chairs as outlined. Jack seconded the motion; motion carried.

#### **New Business:**

There was Board discussion about fining owners for non-compliance issues such as fishing in the lakes and speeding. It was determined that it is unlikely to be enforceable.

Gary requested for Board consideration the hiring of a part-time maintenance person. There was Board discussion of the need. The request was denied at this time.

Men`s Club, Social Club and Welcome Committee: The Men's Club reported that there was a nice Memorial Day Picnic; just over 40 in attendance. There will not be a picnic for the 4<sup>th</sup> of July. The next event will be Labor Day. There was no report from the Social Club. A. J. reported for the Welcome Committee: there was a movie June 8<sup>th</sup>, 25–30 were in attendance including several children. The movie was Mary Poppins Returns. Residents brought snacks. The next event is TBD.

There was a resident concern regarding the small pond on Brookhaven being infested with mosquitoes. The management company will contact the pond company to see if there is anything that they can treat the pond with to deter mosquitoes.

Jack made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:05 PM. Kevin seconded the motion. The meet-ing was adjourned.

The next meeting is scheduled for July 11, 2019 at 7:00 PM


