It was in this context that American workers held the first Labor Day holiday, celebrated on Tuesday, September 5, 1882, in New York City.

By 1894, 23 more states had adopted the holiday, and on June 28, 1894, President Grover Cleveland signed a law making the first Monday in September of each year a national holiday. Enjoy yours!

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
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

SPRINKLER SYSTEM PROBLEMS

AS OF SEPTEMBER 1, 2019, RESIDENTS ARE ASKED TO START CALLING IN ALL IS—SUES IN TO PARKLANE MANAGEMENT. PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE ANY MESSAGES ON THE CLUBHOUSE ANSWERING MACHINE, & DO NOT CONTACT GARY DIRECTLY.

Tall Pines is implementing a new intake system for Sprinkler and Maintenance Issues. As many of you know, in addition to Tall Pines maintenance issues, Gary maintains the sprinkler system throughout Tall Pines. Previously, residents left voicemails on the Clubhouse answering machine, or asked him directly.

<u>Each request will be issued a work order number</u> and this will help Gary to track repeated sprinkler issues that may be stemming from the same root cause. It will also help Gary to balance and prioritize his workload, as we have miles of irrigation running throughout our community that he has to manage.

Any type of sprinkler problem can be reported...i.e, buried, not functioning, needing to be directed away from your home in order to avoid rust stains, etc. Simply call in a ticket to Parklane, and Gary will take care of the problem promptly as always.

You can log your issues with Parklane Management at 727–232–1173. In the near future, a feature will be added to our Tall Pines Website which will allow you to submit a ticket directly through the website via email. Watch your Hi Lites for information on the website feature.

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Tall Pines Board Meeting August 8, 2019 7:00 pm

MINUTES

The meeting was called to order by the President, Dawn Horvath, at 7:00 pm. Board members present were Dawn Horvath, Bud Johnson, Bob Krobatsch, Kevin Van Nort and A. J. Douglas. Absent were David Antkowiak, Jack Brandt, Carl Cassella and Paula Morin. A quorum was established. Dora Steed from Parklane Real Estate Services was also present.

Pledge of Allegiance was observed.

Notice of the meeting was posted in the Hi Lites.

Bud made a motion to approve and waive reading of the June 13, 2019 meeting minutes. Bob seconded the motion; motion carried.

<u>Treasurer`s Report</u>: A. J. presented the Treasurer's Report as of July 31, 2019. Year-to-date income was \$84,183 and expenses were \$86,816. The operating account balance was \$22,980. The total reserves were \$308,442.

<u>Clubhouse Manager`s Report</u>: A. J. reported that there were clubhouse rentals for a wedding in July and a scheduled birthday in August. It was reported that there was a toilet leak in the ladies restroom and that the kitchen sink was draining slow. The library chairs have been put together; however, they are rubbing on the bottom of the tables. Bob will look at the tables to determine a solution. Bob had a vendor come out to repair the stereo receiver. The vendor will remove, repair, and reinstall it for \$100. Dora presented 3 bids for the floor tile cleaning. Kevin made a motion to accept the Dune Rite bid for \$620. A. J. seconded the motion; motion carried. Dora informed the Board that the fire extinguishers were being inspected on August 8th and that the insurance company is requiring an annual inspection/contract.

<u>Crime Watch Report:</u> There was a parking issue over the 4th of July. A vehicle was parked by the guard shack and there was a delay in getting it removed due to the holiday. A traffic meeting was held on June 20^{th.} It was noted that several residents believe there may be illegal activity at a particular home. Residents should call the sheriff's crime tip line should they have a concern. Speed cameras were also discussed, however, they are too expensive. Jack and A. J. are looking for volunteers for a community watch program. So far, there has been little response. It was decided to close off the golf path to slow down speeding.

Old Business:

<u>Clubhouse Sign:</u> The clubhouse sign painting has been delayed due to the rain.

<u>Landscaping project update:</u> Green Thumb replaced several plants that died in the front island. The new ones are not doing well either. The County informed Parklane that they will not be cleaning the area at the Hunt

Ridge entrance. They only clear a specified footage from the actual road (roadway), and this area is not in their

current budget. The cleanup of Upton Court facing Decubellis will be placed on hold until after hurricane

season.

Streets: Derek Berger, from the County, stated that the streets should be deeded back by the end of August.

We will be contacted when the cycle has been completed.

<u>LaQuinta erosion</u>: The erosion is still scheduled to be repaired once the water table goes down.

New Business:

The current towing company contract was discussed. There is an authorization code and either the Board or the

Parking Committee can authorize towing. The Board agreed to keep the existing towing company.

The streetlight behind A. J.'s is staying on. Bud called in the repair.

Kevin informed the Board that an additional street sign (already have the pole) should be ordered for the other

end of Baltusrol and Pineneedles. A quote is needed from Creative Signs.

School starts on Monday and there will be kids out. Residents will need to allow enough time for their travels.

Committee Reports:

Men's Club; Labor Day Party, Monday, September 2nd at 12:00 PM. The Men's Club will donate funds toward a

shuffleboard game for the game room. Jerry will obtain a bid.

Social Club: no meetings

Welcome Committee: no report

A. J. made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:35 PM. Bob seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned.

The next meeting is scheduled for September 12, 2019, 7:00 PM.
