THE COMMUNITY'S HEALTH: BOOSTER SHOTS PFIZER VACCINE

The Pfizer vaccine has received final approval from the FDA. Moderna and Johnson & Johnson are still on Emergency Approval, but are expected to receive Final Approval in the next two months.

Booster shots have been recommended 8 months after your initial shot for Johnson & Johnson and after your second shot of the Pfizer or Moderna vaccine. It has been broadcast that these booster shots will start on September 20th.

The CDC recommends getting the same vaccine for your booster as you did for your initial Covid vaccination. If this is not feasible, your doctor or pharmacist will advise you.

The highly-contagious Delta variant of the Coronavirus has prompted new CDC recommendations, and is causing record number of Covid cases and hospitalizations for unvaccinated adults and children.

"The CDC has updated its mask guidance to recommending that fully vaccinated people wear masks in schools and in other public indoor spaces in areas with high transmission of Covid-19." NY Times

Florida remains a high area of transmission, having the *third highest number of cases in the United States*, following California and Texas.

Once again, without a state mandate, there is a personal choice to be made. How to conduct yourself.



A NEW FUNCTION:

Tall Pines Hands For Our HomelessMaking Sleep Mats for the homeless

The event will be held at the Clubhouse Library every Wednesday at 10:00 a.m.

The sleeping mat is approximately 3' x 6'. The mat has a strong plarn (plastic yarn) shoulder strap, and can be rolled up for carrying. It is very light weight, and is made from 720 cut up disposable plastic shopping bags.

Jeayn Fahey had a request from Fox 13. See her response in the paragraphs below. Helping Hands have just completed 13 of these mats! We owe a grateful "Thank You!" to everyone donating recycled plastic bags from grocery stores to individuals collecting plastic bags for this purpose. We are currently meeting with appropriate contacts to distribute the sleeping mats to our homeless.

"My name is Jeayn Fahey. I started Hands For Our Homeless in June 2021 to gather volunteers to make critically needed sleeping mats for our many homeless neighbors and families, many of whom had been evicted during the pandemic.

So in June when restrictions were lifted and plastic recycle bins surfaced again, two neighbors and I distributed flyers door-to-door in our small Pasco community (Tall Pines) asking if they would come to our Clubhouse to make sleeping mats for our homeless neighbors.

That call-out to our neighbors is, I believe, as remarkable and rewarding as our purpose for being there: Women who hadn't been out of their homes and villas for 15 months came! Women in their 80's and 90's burdened with physical and other disabilities came. "My hands shake and I can't walk, but I can flatten bags!" one said. And she is still flattening bags for us to cut, join into plarn (plastic grocery bag yarn), and crochet into beautiful sleeping mats.

At that first gathering, we met neighbors we hadn't seen in over a year, new neighbors we had never met, and neighbors who cried tears of joy because they were no longer lonely and alone. Oh! The love and joy and laughter in that room! (This must be what quilting bees and sewing circles must have been like, I thought.)

Since that first gathering, we have been "mat making" at our Clubhouse weekly. And "Plarn Parties" are held in villas around our neighborhood. Every day neighbors are visiting each other and delivering balls of plarn to other neighbors to crochet into a sleeping mat. So far we have completed 13 sleeping mats. (See Fox 13 Inquiry attached) We all love giving to others through our sleeping mats project, yet the greatest reward we have been given is the joy, love and friendship we found in each other."

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Maybe all of Tall Pines can benefit!
